#### INTRODUCTION

#### **Winter HAF**

Worcestershire's winter Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) programme is running between Saturday 21st December and Sunday 5th January. There's a huge range of fun activities on offer this winter. Take a look through this brochure to see what we have in store! Please also read below carefully for information on eligibility and the booking process.

#### What is HAF?

Worcestershire Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) Programme is a Department for Education funded programme offering free activities and meals during the school holidays for children aged 5 - 16 who receive benefits-related free school meals (FSM). In addition, limited places are available to other groups of children and young people who are considered financially or otherwise vulnerable. To find out if your child is eligible, go to the 'How to Take Part' page on the Worcestershire County Council Website

All activity clubs are inclusive of Children with SEND and you are welcome to book any of our mainstream activity days. We do also have some specialised SEND clubs on offer, these are run by providers with specialist facilities, training or adapted activities. Please take care on sign up for any of these activities to provide as much information about your child to providers, for example what support your child has at school, it's important that they have this in order to best support and safeguard your child. Please note, HAF activity providers reserve the right to cancel a place if they are not able to support needs as per their risk assessments.

#### The Booking Process for HAF

- 1. You must be registered on the Worcestershire HAF website to be able to book activities. You will not be able to book until you are approved If you haven't already registered, sign up at the Worcestershire HAF Booking Service.
- Once FSM status has been verified, you will receive an email with login details and password for your account.
- 3. You can log in and book sessions for your children. For the winter holidays, each eligible child can book up to 4 free places.

Children in receipt of FSM can book straight on to activities, as the programme is aimed at this group. Children not in receipt of FSM cannot book straight on to activities, as the programme is primarily for FSM children. Therefore, places for non-FSM children are limited and not guaranteed. After finding an activity they would like to book, parents/carers will need to contact the activity provider to discuss their child's needs and the provider's space availability.



## BOOKHERE

#### **Cancelling Bookings / No Shows - HAF**

- If cancelling, this must be done at least 24 hours before activity. If sick on the day please still notify the provider as soon as possible. Other people miss out if you do not cancel with adequate warning or do not show without notifying.
- If you change your mind you must cancel to free up the place before rebooking.

#### **Worcestershire's Groups Activities and Short Breaks**

Worcestershire's Groups Activities and Short Breaks (GA&SB) is a scheme to secure places at specialist activity clubs throughout the year for children and young people (aged 5- 18) with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND).

#### Targeted Groups and Activities advertised in this booklet:

- Are for those unable to access mainstream activities.
- Are specialised for Children and young people with SEND.
- Involves a mix of respite and stay-and-play groups.
- Read on to find the list of targeted providers and their offerings.

There is additional support available too. If your child can access <u>Universal Services</u> or requires <u>Specialist Services</u> such as short breaks, go <u>here</u> for more information.

#### **FAQs**

**Can I access both HAF and GASB?** Yes, if child or young person with SEND is in receipt of benefits related Free School Meals (FSM) they are eligible for both programmes.

There are also limited HAF places for Children and Young People with SEND (non-FSM Eligible), please sign up and then contact the HAF provider directly to discuss availability.

Please note that while HAF is free for eligible young people, parents/carers may have to pay a fee to access GASB. There are a number of subsidised places available through GASB for targeted groups and activities so parents/carers can pay similar rates as for universal places. Once all subsidised places have been filled, parents/carers have the option to pay full price for their child.

**Is transport funded as part of GASB or HAF?** Transport can be challenging for families with both disabled and non-disabled children. Travel Assistance for either programme is not provided as a matter of course. Families are encouraged to consider if they are eligible for the Motability element of their Disability Living Allowance and whether this could support their travel.

More SEND specific providers are being added in 2025 for both HAF and GA&SB so if you can't find anything for this winter don't worry as you may still find something next year!! We also know that a lot of the activities are closed. If you are interested but there isn't space now, email enquiries@hafworcestershire.co.uk to register your interest and be put on the waiting list.
