| 1. | Is the side and rear of your home protected against intruders? See page 12 | | Good security fences and lockable gates can deter intruders. |
| 2. | Are your gardens well maintained? See page 14 | | Intruders are more likely to target homes that look uncared for. |
| 3. | Are your garages and sheds secure? See page 13 | | Fit strong locks to sheds and garage doors. |
| 4. | Is there good visibility to the front of your home? See page 12 | | Keeping the height of shrubs and hedges low, can prevent burglars from working on a property unseen. |
| 5. | Are all external doors and vulnerable areas lit? See page 13 | | Good external dusk to dawn lighting can deter burglars. |
| FR 6. | CONT/REAR DOORS Is your front door solid and in good condition? See page 6 | | The door should be solid, strong and free from cracks and warping. |
| 7. | Is your door frame in good condition? | | The frame should be as strong as the door |
| 8. | Does your door have a door viewer, or some other method of seeing who is outside without unlocking the door? See page 6 | | Door viewers allow you to see who's at the door, before opening it. |
| 9. | Does your front door have a door chain or similar device? See page 6 | | These allow you to greet visitors safely. 'If in Doubt, Kee, Them Out'. |
| 10. | Does your front door have a 5 lever mortice lock and night-latch or multi-point locking system? See page 7 | | A mortice lock should be at least a 5 lever lock certified to BS3621. |
| 11. | . Is your letter box 16 inches (40cm) away from any door locks? See page 6 | | A letterbox deflector prevents thieves reaching in and opening locks from the inside. |
| 12. | . Are your back door frames in good condition? | | The frame should be as strong as the door. |
| 13. | Do your back doors have 5 level mortice locks and two mortice bolts, or a multi-point locking system? See page 6 | | A mortice lock should be at least a 5 lever lock certified to BS3621. |
| 14. | Are your patio doors fitted with an additional patio door lock? See page 8 | | Additional patio locks can stop patio doors from being lifted off the rails. |
| 15. | Do you keep your doors locked even when your home is occupied? | | A distraction burglar will often enter an occupied home through an unlocked door. |

| WINDOWS 16. Do you have locks on all of your windows? (With the exception of designated fire escapes). See page 10 | | If the glass has been smashed, a locked window cannot be opened. |
| 17. If you have French windows, are they secure? See page 8 | | Mortice and hinge bolts should be fitted to both doors. |
| ALARMS 18. Does your home have a burglar alarm? See page 15 | | An alarm is a powerful deterrent to burglary. Always activate your alarm before going to bed. |
| 19. Does your home have smoke alarms? | | For a free home fire safety check contact your local fire service. See page 21 |
| PROPERTY MARKING 20. Are your personal valuable items security marked See page 17 | ? 🗆 | Homes protected by Smartwater are five times less likely to be burgled. |
| 21. Have you got a record of your personal/valuable items? See page 22 | | Record details of your valuables on the enclosed property record sheet in this guide. |
| GOOD HOUSEKEEPING 22. Do you keep all keys out of sight of doors and windows? | | Remember thieves can hook keys through your letterbox. |
| 23. Do you keep all valuables out of sight? | | Do not position valuable items so they can be seen from outside. Blinds or net curtains can be used to limit views. |
| 24. Have you removed any valuable property stored in sheds or garages? See page 13 | | Sheds and garages are not designed for secure storage. |
| 25. Do you have a smoke alarm, on each level of you home that you check every week? | r 🗌 | Change the battery in your smoke alarm every year. Replace your smoke alarm every ten years. |
